#### IX. Technical Committee Report - Ray W8PIE

The 2-meter repeater was put on a Station Monitor. The cavities are Ok on transmit, but cannot be "notched" on receive. There is something *seriously wrong* with the receive cavities. They cannot be adjusted and must be repaired. The repeater itself is FINE and has been repaired.

Paul has a 6-can set of cavities that he may be able to "work us a deal on". There are three options for the cavities:

- Come up with a cost for GMARC to purchase the 6-can cavities
- Borrow the 6-can cavities while ours are being repaired
- 2-meter Repeater will be "off the air" while our cavities are being repaired

If #1 comes to pass, then GMARC will have a "spare set" of cavities that we will have to decide what to do with. Perhaps we will donate them to Macomb Community College or Handi-Hams.
