VI. SKYWARN Recognition Day 30-Nov-2012 (Gaylord, MI) - Scott W1BIC

Scott W1BIC gave a summary of the statistics for the team of Amateur Operators that participated in National SKYWARN Recognition Day at the Gaylord, MI Weather Station (WX8APX) on 30-Nov-2012 thru 1-Dec-2012. There were (4) GMARC members who participated -- Rich KC8HMJ, Linda KD8SAI, Bobby N8CY, and Scott W1BIC.

The weather was 29° F with 3" of snow on the ground at arrival, and the team put up "wire" antennae and made ready for the contest -- which began at 0000 Zulu (1900 EST) on Friday evening. The contest continued through 1900 EST on Saturday, and the team made a total of 39 contacts -- including 26 Weather Stations. Each Weather Station contact earned 2-points and "other" contacts earned 1-point.

The team earned a total of 65-points (26-Weather + 13-other) which earned an "EF-5 Tornado Achievement Certificate" for the Gaylord, MI Weather Station [4th from the *highest* level]. If the team had earned 2 more points, it would have earned a "Category 1 Hurricane Achievement Certificate".

A good time was had by all, and Scott W1BIC provided free lodging for out-of-town operators at **The Waters Inn** -- which is only 3-miles from the Weather Station. Rich KC8HMJ was operating on his snazzy Software Defined Radio (SDR), and Scott W1BIC was using his trusty iCom HF rig. Band conditions were not the best, but not all that bad either. Most of the contacts were made on 40 meters LSB, with most of the remaining on 20 meters USB. There were 2-contacts on 80 meters LSB.

A copy of the contact log for WX8APX was provided to all meeting attendees with Weather Station contacts highlighted in "Red". (If you were not *in attendance* at the meeting, you have **no idea** of the significance of this statement!)

Scott W1BIC invited all GMARC members to participate next year -- the first weekend after Thanksgiving 2013 at the Gaylord Weather Station -- same deal: Free Lodging at **The Waters Inn** for out-of-town participants! (www.TheWatersInn.com)

X. Presentation + Discussion: Proposed Change to GMARC By-Laws

Kurt W1BIC gave an overview of the Proposed By-Laws Change (DRAFT v1.5 previously sent via eMail to all GMARC members, and copies of which were available at the meeting). The purpose of this change is to create a new class of membership in GMARC -- Heritage Members. This new class of membership is designated specifically for *former* members of the organization known as **The Firebird Radio Club** -- the first General Motors amateur radio club -- founded in 1966.

Val N8OEF asked what would be the "benefit" of a former Firebird joining GMARC. There were numerous answers given my several different Club members; e.g. "recognition", "unity", common participation in InfoNets, etc.

It was noted by Scott W1BIC that The Firebird ARC is part of the Generations of GM History and is *proudly* acknowledged at the **GM Heritage** web site:

Scott further stated that the purpose of Heritage Membership is to honor and celebrate members of the *first* General Motors amateur radio club.

After considerable discussion, a motion was made by Bobby N8CY and seconded by Robbin K1KNN to "Approved the wording of the proposed By-Laws Change -- as contained in a DRAFT v1.5 dated 10-Dec-2012". Motion passed.

Passing of this motion "starts the clock" on the By-Laws approval process (as defined in the GMARC By-Laws). This process requires the Secretary to send-out (via eMail or US Mail) a copy of the approved wording prior to the next meeting (15-Jan-2013) where the Ballot Vote will be taken to approve the proposed changes.

Dues Paid members can vote by Absentee Ballot if they are unable to attend the 15-Jan-2013 meeting. Absentee Ballots were available at this meeting, and some members cast Absentee Ballots -- which will be counted in January, 2013 when the final Ballot Vote will occur. A plurality (50%) of votes cast is required to approve a By-Laws Change for GMARC.
