X. Old / New Busness

Robbin K1KNN gave a report on H.R. 1301 – The Amateur Radio Parity Act. A hearing was held on Capitol Hill on January 12th by Rep Greg Walker W7EQI (R-OR) who called the resolution "a commonsense bill" and urged his colleagues to support it. The primary addition of H.R. 1301 (vs. PRB-1 – codified into Michigan Law as P.A. 556) is that it addresses CCRs for private land use restrictions.

XII.Remote Control of HF Radio – Scott W1BIC

Scott W1BIC made an interesting and informative presentation on various methods for remote control of an HF radio via a cell phone (or internet connectivity). The solution that Scot has is called Remote Shack and costs \$479 + \$49 for a cable specific to the HF radio controlled. He can control all aspects of radio operation from touch tones on a cell phone – using HRD commands.

Other solutions that were discussed are:

- iCom RS-BA1 Software
- Elecraft K3 / K0 combination \$3,000
- RemoteHamRadio.com 7 world class stations that are available on a subscription basis for \$99/year + \$.09/minute usage charge

As an aside, Scott mentioned an internet PowerStrip for approx. \$130 that can ping Google, and if it loses its ping, it can reset an outlet on the PowerStrip. This can be very useful to reset an internet router if it needs to be reset. There are various additional programming features available for the PowerStrip.
